

Installation Requirements

Before commencing installation of the new product, ensure that the system has been flushed to remove any debris, which could cause damage to the valves and invalidate the warranty.

Installation

- Remove the Backnut (8) and Backnut Washer (7) from Thread Pipe
 (6)
- 2. Then place the Thread Pipes through the bath holes with the Base Plate (5) and Base Plate Washer (9) correctly positioned under each pillar, fully covering the mounting holes.
- Place the Backnut Washer (7) and Backnuts (8) back onto the Thread Pipes, under the bath and screw up until the tap is secured in position (DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN)

NOTE: Additional sealant can be used if required.

- 4. Connect the water supply pipes to the tails and tighten
- 5. An adequate sealing method should be used to create a watertight seal.
- 6. Identify a suitable location for the wall bracket, so that the hose will not be under tension when fitted.
- 7. Attach to the wall using the plugs and screws supplied
- 8. Fit a hose washer into each side of the hose
- 9. Connect one end of the hose to mixer outlet and the other end to the handset.
- 10. Reinstate the water supply and check for any leaks.





Line Drawing


